Investing in Care Closer to Home - improving services for today and future generations

LEAGUE AGREE £188,000 FOR HASLEMERE HOSPITAL

The League of Friends of Haslemere Hospital committee, meeting on Monday (20th) agreed to spend some £188,000 on improvements and equipment at Haslemere Hospital.

We have already paid £20,000 on decorating the Outpatients Department and a further £35,000 will be paid for renovations to provide a Point of Care area, and the balance of decoration of the Outpatient Department.

Cardiology services are the first tranche of services in the Pro-Active Community Health Hub - yesterday we pledged to fund an Echocardiogram, heart monitors and the latest ECG equipment. Cardiac rehabilitation already takes place in the hospital and with adapted space in the hub it will provide a full Heart Failure service.

It is an exciting time to see Haslemere blossom with an array of services being delivered to meet the needs of the community. It is a pioneering opportunity for Haslemere. The new services being delivered are for adults of any age.
