Humphries Field Analyser £32,000

This sophisticated equipment is a tool for accurately measuring human visual field defects, particularly in cases of glaucoma. A vital tool for ophthalmologists, the acquisition enhances the ophthalmic facilities available at the hospital.

Hoverjack Air Patient Lift £8,000

The Hoverjack allows staff to safely lift patients who have fallen without assembling a lift team. It can also be used in the home and for the transfer of patients from stretcher to bed and vice versa. It can also be used for the movement of Bariatric patients.

Dermascope £2,000

A dermascope is a handheld device used for clinical examination of suspicious skin lesions and assists diagnosis by dermatological staff.
