During 2022, the League of Friends provided the hospital with equipment not available from NHS funds, totalling over £70,000. Key among items was a glaucoma Visual Field Analyser costing £33,000 thereby enabling patients to be seen at Haslemere rather than having to take the journey to Guildford.
